### **Michelle Yang – Tennis**

Sophomore Michelle Yang finished her final singles match against Charlotte Latin to complete a 14-0 undefeated record for the season. She is also the top contender for CISAA “Player of the Year”

### **Maiden McLoughlin - Volleyball**

Sophomore Maiden McLoughlin was instrumental in the Chargers’ 3-1 victory over Carmel Christian in the NCISAA playoffs helping advance the team to the quarterfinals. The Chargers lost but Maiden lead the team offensively in both matches earning 27 kills, 5 aces, 17 digs and a serve receive rating on 1.89 (out of 3).

### **Carly Arrington – Cross Country**

Freshman Carly Arrington placed 3rd at the NCISAA 4A State Meet on Saturday. Carly had an incredible season and she's only a freshman. She raced with passion and excitement each race of the season. Carly ran 19:12 over the 5k course at McAlpine Park which ranks her 10th All-Time on PDXC list and 2nd among 9th graders. It was a tremendous effort!

### **Nickel Fields - Football**

Senior Nickel Fields helped lead the Chargers past Charlotte Latin in the semi-final round of the CISAA tournament. Nickel had 14 carries for 156 yards and a TD. He also had 2 catches for 26 yards and contributed 8 tackles while playing defense

### **Christian Landis – Cross Country**

Senior Christian Landis won his 2nd individual NCISAA state title in dominating fashion. He led wire to wire going out in under 4:50 for the first mile and finished in an incredible time of 15:26. That is sub-5:00 pace per mile for 3.1 miles! He also led the team, along with fellow seniors Colter Nichols & John Smith, to a 4th consecutive NCISAA 4A state title. Christian finished 6th, 1st, 2nd, and 1st in his XC career at the state meet. His career is one of the most notable in PDXC history!
