INCLEMENT WEATHER

In the event of a school closing due to inclement weather or another emergency, please reference Early Emergency Dismissal For Parents. Parents will be notified via Connect5.

THORGUARD

ThorGuard is a lightning prediction system that provides the campus with the ability to mitigate a hazardous situation by notifying everyone in advance. Thor-Guard operates as follows:

- One 15-second Thor-Guard horn blast notifies everyone on campus of the need to go immediately inside a building and seek shelter from severe weather. (The strobe light on the Thor-Guard antenna will flash for the duration of the lightning alert.)
- An announcement over the p.a. system will follow the Thor-Guard horn blast to notify everyone who is indoors to stay inside until further notice.
- Anyone outdoors should go indoors. No one may leave a building unless a student is released to a parent who has come into the building to take his/her child.
- When the threat of lightning has passed, three 5-second Thor-Guard horn blasts will sound and an announcement over the p.a. system will state that the alert has ended.

More often than not, the Thor-Guard system activates and the siren sounds during afternoon carpool. If this is the case, teachers will keep students indoors. If it appears that we will be under Thor-Guard alert for an extended period of time, you will be notified via Connect5 and provided further instructions.
