



2017 -2018 Athletic Success At A Glance

- In 2017 – 2018, Providence Day School fielded 27 varsity teams with an overall total of 66 teams competing in grades 7 through 12
- The 66 teams translated to 1,421 roster spots
- The teams won 6 CISAA conference championships, 2 NCISAA state championships, and 6 NCISAA runner-up trophies
- Collectively, the varsity teams achieved an average cumulative GPA of 3.78
- Boys Basketball won the Chick-fil-A Basketball Tournament in Atlanta. Also, they were one of only three schools in the United States to be invited to the inaugural China vs US Youth Basketball Spectacular
- Girls Basketball won their 100 consecutive conference basketball game and also won the Charleston Holiday Basketball Tournament
- Boys Basketball had 2 players nominated for the McDonald’s All-American game and Girls Basketball had 1 player nominated.
- All-American honors, including a McDonald’s Boys Basketball All-American, were awarded to 3 Charger student-athletes (boys basketball and 2 for boys lacrosse)
- Varsity Swimming had a program high of 33 swimmers qualifying for the NCISAA tournament
- All-Conference honors were awarded to 112 Charger student-athletes
- All-State honors were awarded to 47 Charger student-athletes
- 23 student-athletes won individual NCISAA state championships
- 5 student-athletes were named CISAA “Player of the Year”
- Varsity Boys Cross Country won their 18th consecutive CISAA championship
- Varsity Girls Track and Field won their 6th consecutive NCISAA championship
- 19 members of the class of 2017 will be participating in intercollegiate sports
- 2 Charger coaches were acknowledged as “Coach of the Year”
- Providence Day won the Wells Fargo Cup competition making it six out of the previous seven years
