Katerina Peroulas – Soccer

Kat scored 5 goals and added 1 assist in Friday's 9-0 Charger win over Wesleyan Christian Academy in the NCISAA Quarter-Finals. Currently, Kat is one of the most explosive forwards in NC scoring 17 goals and 15 assists in her second high school regular season. Kat is a versatile player and can play central or out in the wide areas and plays very well with her back to the goal. She also has the ability to dribble and drive and can shoot with both feet. She is already attracting interest and offers from SEC and Ivy League Schools.

Jason Krell – Track and Field

Junior Jason Krell had a huge two days at the CISAA Championships. Jason won individual titles in the 1600 & 800 and anchored the winning 4x800 team. He also placed 2nd in the 3200 on Thursday night. Krell raced a total of 6,400m over the two-day meet, and his final 800 meters was covered in 1:57.00 which ranks 12th in NC. Krell's times were 2:01 (split in 4x800 win), 9:39 in 3200, 4:27 in 1600, and 1:57 in 800. The passion and "fire" that Jason brings to each and every race is noticed by all. He is a remarkable competitor! Jason's outstanding performance established him as *The Charlotte Observer's* "Athlete of the Week."

Ikem Ekwonu – Track and Field

Senior Ikem Ekwonu placed 2nd in the discus and 3rd in the shot put at the CISAA Conference Championships. Most years Ikem's performances this past week would be good enough to win state titles in both events. It just so happens that this year is the most competitive these two events have ever been in CISAA and NCISAA history. Ikem threw 153 feet in the discus which is #2 All-Time in school history. He threw the shot 48 feet and 5 inches which also ranks him #2 in school history.

John Miralia – Baseball

Junior John Miralia went 4-4 at the plate for the Chargers in their quarter-final round of the NCISAA state championship game against Wake Christian Academy. John had three singles, a solo home run and contributed 2 RBI's. He also came in for relief and got the save helping Owen Tappy get his 8th win of the season.


Ethan Robinette – Lacrosse
